The author, Ph.D engineer Nicolae Costake (ex director of Computer Center during 1970-1982) presented an important communication as a matter of fact a Project for a relatively new topic.

Out of the introduction and a brief presentation of actual steps, we underline the following: “(...) Human society passes through a complex crisis, whose solve involves new models and steps.(...) Romania provides examples of lower quality in human behavior within several fields(...)”.

The author refers to specialized literature, few books (recent publications) out of which results: disindustrialisation, imports on debt, humanity of the XXI century, a multilateral analysis of global problems, economic situation in continuous crisis, other aspects.

A high level model of socio-economic system (SES) was presented.

Mr. Nicolae Costake mentioned that SES is an element of a hierarchical structure: Cosmos –Terra – SES (natural resources, mankind, artifacts) which is submitted to some physical, cosmic and telluric cycles. SES structure includes five subsystems and several relations. Then he presented the high level model of enterprise, being pointed out few differences between enterprise management and social management, GDP/capita of EU member states, ex countries of ‘socialist system’ (having as source EUROSTAT 2010-2011), selection of managers in the context of information society management, information infrastructure and information needed by society management (MSI) regarding EU conception, a very high level functional model of interoperability national system (SNI). High level functional model of SNI technical architecture, a high level model of public institution organization in the context of SNI, SNI/MSI – comments and conclusions; a very high level model of MSI.

Finally, mr. Nicolae Costake underlined that “Romania is in the position to recover again delays, this time in the field of information technology, that of interoperability of information systems of public institutions, this step being pursued by all EU member states”.

The seminar debates in February (one of actions with a numerous participation) were run by Ph.D professor Constantin Anghelache, SRS vice president.

ASSURE THE STATISTICAL DATA AND INFORMATION DISSEMINATION OF OFFICIAL STATISTICS -CONTINUATION-

“Official statistics data produced by the National Institute of Statistics and by other producers of official statistics represent a national good of public interest and are accessible under equity conditions as volume and data quality and simultaneity of their dissemination to all the users” (...)
Law 226/2009 (regarding official statistics organization and functioning in Romania – article 32/chapter XI)

In order to provide dissemination during 2013 too, for statistical data and information to all the categories of users, within the National Institute of Statistics an intensive activity took place as along many years, namely: **Catalogue 2013 – Statistical publications and services** (list of statistical publications and their price); **Catalogue of statistical publications 2013** (number of publications and date of issue); **Order – statistical publications** (for subscriptions).

INS elaborates and disseminates, according to legal provisions, statistical publications on paper support and electronic format, being able to be also procured with pay from the bookstore “Ion Ionescu de la Brad”.

In the complex process of official statistics data and information dissemination, **Catalogue 2013 – statistical publications and services**, elaborated by INS, bilingual (Romanian-English) was and is appreciated by the users, each year, since the first year of issue.

Catalogue 2013 includes important clarifications for the whole system of statistical publications of synthesis and for services from existent databases. For each publication there are presented by case the period of issue and approximate number of pages, support (paper, CD), format (including electronic), price (lei and euro).

Catalogue 2013 also clarifies about the content of each publication (into Romanian and English) orienting the users both for general publications and for specific ones by activity field.

The other catalogue, **Catalogue of statistical publications 2013**, elaborated by INS, titles of publications have been forecast for each calendar month, reference period and date of issue. It results that in INS specialized directions, in 2013 238 publications are to be elaborated. Most of them are forecast to be issued in May (31) and in November (29). It is known that in INS for the activity “dissemination of Romanian statistical information”, according to the stipulations in the catalogue, there are also replied the demands of data and information from various categories of users: public administration, international organizations and embassies.

It is underlined that out of databases organized and permanently maintained, INS provides statistical services for all the categories of users of official statistics data and information. We refer to **databases** regarding: population and demographic phenomena, foreign trade (BEX), industrial physical production (PFIND), BDL (at locality level), BDJ (at country level).

There are also organized important **statistical registers and classifications**: SIRUTA (territorial administrative units register), REGIS (enterprises statistical register), CANE Rev. 2 (classification of activities in the national economy), CPASA 2008 (classification of products and associated services), as well as on internet, accessing www.insse.ro.

The **library “Nicolae Georgescu-Roegen”** provides international exchange of publications. INS library improves the book fund and documents in relations with international bodies from numerous countries.

We underline that in order to assure statistical data and information dissemination, **Order statistical publications 2013** – form elaborated by INS, is strictly necessary to all the users of official statistics data and information. Order provides statistical publications by subscription including useful clarifications regarding the title of publications (112 titles) stipulated to be issued in 2013 according to periodicity of issue – printed or electronic format. Titles are grouped in: annual statistical publications, periodical statistical publications, operative statistical publications; publications issued based on the population and housing census (RPL/2011), statistical publications in stock – with specifications regarding the selling price (lei), number of subscriptions, value (lei) and total value (lei). By means of order, there are also stipulations regarding the procedure of money pay in INS account and how to issue the invoices.
